Tree Trimming Available

If you have low-hanging tree branches in front of your house on the parkway, you can call the city at 311 and request tree trimming. Ask for a confirmation number. If you do not get a response within a couple of weeks, call 311 again and give them the confirmation number. They will be able to call up your number and let you know when the job is scheduled to be done. If the tree or bushes are located on private property, the owners are responsible for trimming.
