## CUBA SI ! BORING? NO.

Last year's hottest new food place appeared on Lawrence Avenue, the Vietnamese sandwich haven Nhu Lan. This year's best is also ethnic, also essentially for sandwiches, and also on Lawrence. Con Sabor Cubano is a wonderful addition to the neighborhood, located at 2739 W. Lawrence, uneasily next door to the live bunnies and chickens place.

Con Sabor is a small space, with three tables and a counter that seats six, so much of its business is carry-out. A family-run affair, the Lopez family offers half a dozen classic Cuban sandwiches, such as pan con lechon (roasted pork) and ropavieja (shredded beef). So far I have sampled (okay, actually devoured) four selections, and every one was a pleasure. There is usually a daily special, such as a seafood paella, which is the only item over \$7.00. There are also home-made milkshakes in Cuba-type favors, like mango or papaya, also wonderful.

Breakfast is also served daily, a small menu of omelettes and eggs, with cafe con leche and bread and butter, all with a very tropical favor, which is revolutionary in these parts. Con Sabor Cubano is open from 8:00 to 8:00, so you should be able to find time to visit our latest local gem.
