NEW AREA CODE

Effective November 7, 2009, all local calls will have to follow new dialing procedures; this means that you will need to dial 1+ the area + telephone number for all local calls in the (312 or 773) areas. If you don't, your call will not be completed and a recording will instruct you to hang up and dial again.

This change is because of the addition of a new area code of 872 to the same area served by both 312 and 773. This also means that beginning November 7, 2009, new telephone lines or services may be assigned numbers with the new 872 area code.
