Attendees enjoyed fancy hors d'oevres, mini martinis, and other libations as they shopped and chatted for about three hours, and all agreed that it was a very fun night.

This fundraiser was earmarked for a full time Music Program, and brought in \$13,038 of the \$40,000 goal. Tickets were \$100 per person, with \$50 of that going directly to Waters School, the other \$50 going back to the buyer in the form of a Crate & Barrel Gift Card.

Governor Blagojevich, who had been personally invited, took the opportunity to stop by and announce to Principal Kipp that he would pledge between \$5,000 and the amount this event raised for the program. Waters School is surely looking forward to that!
